It is part of EABH's strategic plan to modernize the school and remain relevant for years to come.



NUMBER OF DONORS PER GIVING LEVEL





THE EABH FUTURE CAMPAIGN IS AN ONGOING FUNDRAISING **EFFORT TO SUPPORT EABH'S VISION AND LONG-TERM PRIORITIES.**

The donations directed towards EABH Future Campaign between 2019-2021 are being invested to equip Bloco 1's diverse learning spaces. The construction of Bloco 1 was concluded in 2021 and funded by the Association Fee Reserve.

Bloco 1 offers 12 new learning spaces, including an outdoor patio on the rooftop. The new building features green technology components that include natural ventilation, rainwater harvesting, and natural lighting to reduce artificial lighting requirements.






HIGHLIGHTS 2021
