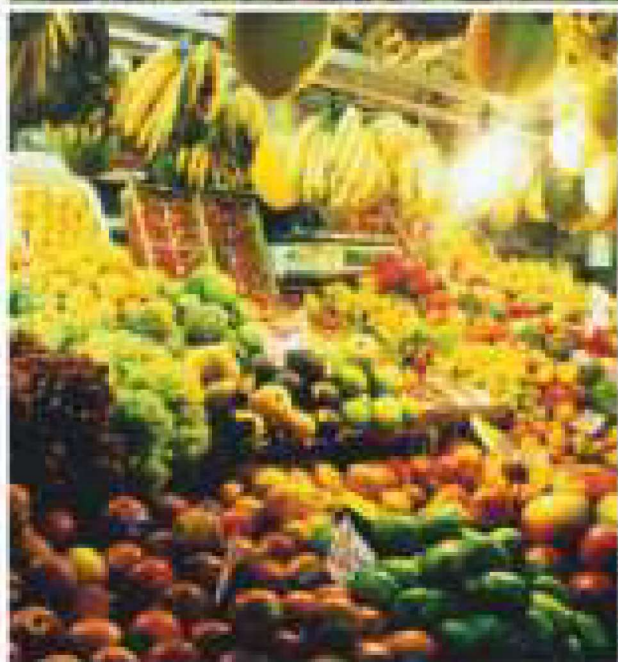
Beagã (Belo Horizonte's nickname) is the capital of Minas Gerais. Belo Horizonte has over 5 million people, but retains a small-town feel.
